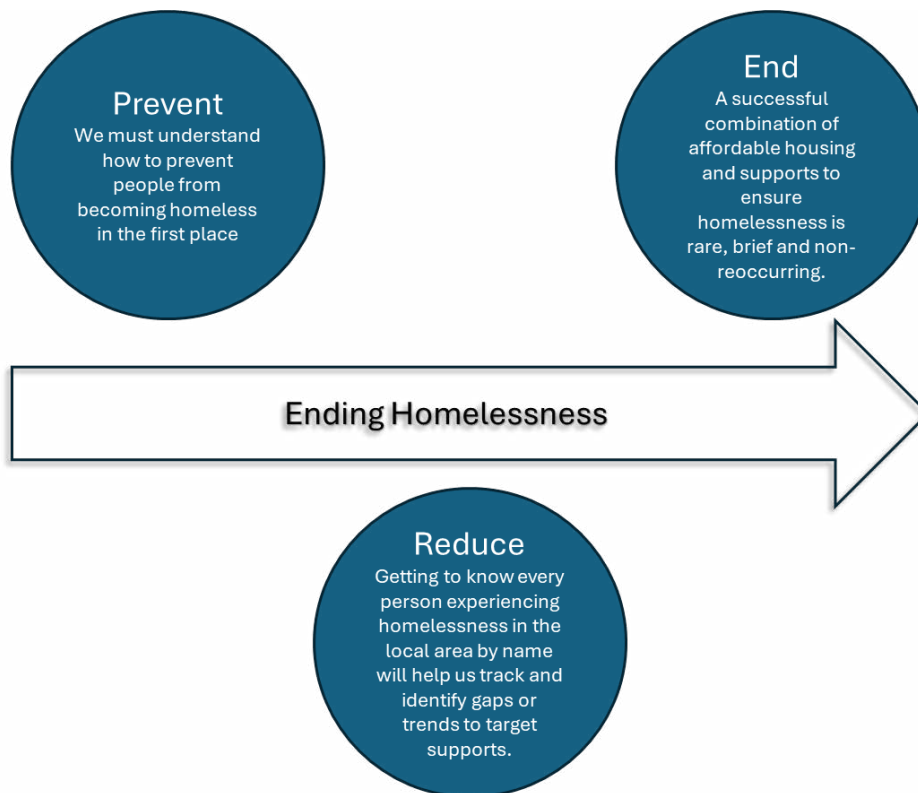


### ABOUT SC ZERO

Sunshine Coast (SC) Zero brings the Advance to Zero framework to the Sunshine Coast. Advance to Zero is used in communities around the world to address homelessness. The goal is to prevent, reduce and eventually end homelessness, starting with rough sleeping.

Homelessness on the Sunshine Coast can and should be solved. This requires a continued commitment for organisations on the in the region to work together. This will allow for a sharing of resources toward the collective vision of preventing, reducing, and ending homelessness on the Sunshine Coast.

Like other Zero communities across Australia, SC Zero adopts the Advance to Zero methodology, driven by a unified vision to end all homelessness, beginning with rough sleeping. The approach ensures that if homelessness does occur, it is rare, brief and a one-time event (AAEH, 2024). This state is referred to as reaching Functional Zero.



### OUR PURPOSE

SC Zero will work towards reducing homelessness overall and end rough sleeping on the Sunshine Coast by 2035 by working with people we know by name.

### OUR VISION

SC Zero is committed to the belief that everyone deserves a home and that homelessness can be solved through community collaboration. We strive to ensure that when homelessness does occur, it is rare, brief and non-recurring.



## OUR KEY PILLARS

- **Quality Real-Time Data:** We maintain and update a By Name List (BNL), striving to ensure that every homeless individual on the SC is known by name. This list also includes crucial information about their physical and mental health, as well as their housing needs.
- **A Coordinated Response:** Ending homelessness requires a unified effort. By working together, we can maximize the use of our limited resources.
- **Advocating for Systems Change:** The data we collect helps us identify gaps, trends, and areas where resources should be focused for maximum effectiveness. We believe that every individual and family deserves adequate housing.
- **Matching Housing and Health:** Using the Australian Homelessness Vulnerability Triage Tool (AHVTT), we match service delivery to ensure every individual and family receives the support they need.

## SC ADMIN SUPPORT

IFYS will assist SC Zero with the following campaign administration tasks:

- **Processing Database Access Requests:** Handling requests for access to the Advance to Zero Database.
- **Training and Support:** Providing training and support for organisations to help staff utilise the AHVTT and database effectively.
- **Membership List Maintenance:** Maintaining and updating the membership list to ensure confidentiality is respected.
- **Data and Reporting:** Supplying data and reports as requested.
- **Meeting Coordination:** Compiling agendas and providing meeting minutes for SC Zero.
- **Facilitating Coordination Groups:** Convening and facilitating coordination groups.
- **Policy Contribution:** Assisting in using relevant data to contribute to government policy, including submissions and public forums. Consent for logo use will be requested for relevant activities.

## FEEDBACK AND CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT

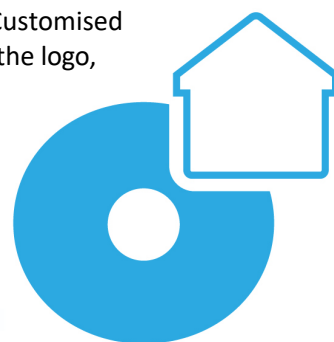

- Participate in feedback surveys for SC Zero activities and meetings.
- Join SC Zero improvement groups.
- Engage in external evaluation activities and surveys.

## PUBLICITY AND DATA USAGE

To enhance the impact of SC Zero, all participants and collaborators will have their logos prominently displayed in relevant publicity materials, reports, presentations, and public documentation. This will increase the visibility and recognition of each member's involvement and commitment to the project.

Collective data will be accessible to all members and the wider public on our website. Customised reports can be made upon request. Publications must include an acknowledgment, and the logo, of the SC Zero project
